Azerbaijan has defined a strategic path for sustainable development by prioritizing 17 SDGs, 88 targets, and 119 indicators across economic, social, and environmental domains. Through tailored educational and research opportunities, NSU prepares its students to become knowledgeable and responsible citizens capable of contributing meaningfully to sustainable development.



Government Coordination and NSU's Support

In Azerbaijan, the National Coordination Council for Sustainable Development plays a central role in aligning the nation's efforts to meet the SDGs. In solidarity with this council's initiatives, NSU equips its students and staff with extensive knowledge and practical skills related to sustainable development. The university integrates Azerbaijan's SDG priorities into its curriculum and projects, fostering an environment that encourages awareness and action around these global goals.

Accelerating Sustainable Development and Innovation in Education
